Report: Your PPT slide presentation will serve as your final group report and is due after your presentation on 3/13/08.

Description

The final presentation is a summary of all activities of the Field Methods class. Be sure to discuss activities during all 4 field trips and 4 labs as well as topics presented during the 9 lectures of the term. Each student is expected to present a part of the research and analyses undertaken. It is entirely up to the students to organize the presentation although I highly recommend designating a presentation coordinator.

Compare and contrast the physical, hydrological, and biological characteristics, both natural and anthropogenic, of Tecolote Creek and Bell Canyon Creek watersheds in the context of other South Coast watersheds and in the recovery effort for southern Steelhead in the Southern California Distinctive Population Segment (DPS) or Evolutionary Significant Unit (ESU).

You will have 50 minutes for your oral presentation and 20 minutes for questions. Each student in the class is expected to present an equal amount of the material presented.
